

**BIRMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL
(LOZELLS LOW TRAFFIC NEIGHBOURHOOD)
(ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) (EXPERIMENTAL) ORDER 2020**

Birmingham City Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 9, 10(1) and 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

1. Commencement and citation

- 1.1 This Order shall come into operation on the 19th November Two Thousand and Twenty and may be cited as the “Birmingham City Council (Lozells Low Traffic Neighbourhood) (One-Way Traffic) (Experimental) Order 2020”.

2. Interpretation

- 2.1 In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:

“Council” means Birmingham City Council or its successors as Highway authority;

“Dispensation Permit” means a permit issued by the Council for the purpose of exempting a specified vehicle from a provision imposed by this Order;

“Highway” means all Carriageways, Footways, Central Reservations and verges;

“Mechanical Road Cleansing Vehicle” means a vehicle used for the purposes of cleaning the Highway;

“Pedal Cycle” has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;

“Road” means any length of Highway or any other road to which the public has access, and includes bridges over which a road passes as set out in Section 142(1) of the Act;

- 2.2 For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying:

a Dispensation Permit in the relevant position if it is displayed in a similar manner as a Disabled Person's Badge as prescribed by the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 (as amended);

- 2.3 Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article is a reference to the Article bearing that number in this Order.

- 2.4 Where in any Article in this Order, reference is made to columns 2, 3 or 4 as appropriate of the Schedule, these references relate to the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule.

- 2.5 Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.

- 2.6 The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment provided that where a prohibition or restriction which is imposed by this Order is in conflict with a prohibition or restriction imposed by a previous Order (except any Order made under Section 14 of the Act), then the provision of this Order shall prevail.
- 2.7 The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 2.8 In pursuance of section 10(2) of the Act, the Assistant Director of Transport and Connectivity or a person authorised by the Assistant Director of Transport and Connectivity, if it appears to that person essential (a) in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic, or (b) in the interests of the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on the Highway, or (c) for the preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any Road affected by this Order runs, and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police, may modify or suspend any provision of this Order, save that no modification shall make an addition.

3. One Way Streets

- 3.1 Save as provided in Article 4, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in any Road specified in column 1 of the Schedule between those lengths specified in column 2, in a direction other than that specified in column 3, subject to any exceptions, specified in column 4.

4. Exemption for Mechanical Road Cleansing and other special vehicles

Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to:

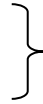
- (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform;
- (b) the driving of any Mechanical Road Cleansing vehicle being used in pursuance of statutory powers;
- (c) a vehicle which displays a Dispensation Permit in the relevant position,
