

## BIRMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL (LOZELLS LOW TRAFFIC NEIGHBOURHOODS) (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (EXPERIMENTAL) (NO.2) ORDER 2020

NOTICE is hereby given that the above named Council have made the above Order under Sections 9, 10(1) and 10(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) the effect of which will be to introduce waiting restrictions on Hunters Road, Finch Road and Archibald Road.

The Orders will come into operation on 24th December 2020.

The above named Council will consider in due course whether this Experimental Order should be made permanent. Persons wishing to object to the making of the permanent Order must, within six months of the date the Order comes into operation or the date of any modification which might be made, send a statement in writing, including the grounds for their objection to the Assistant Director Transport & Connectivity, PO Box 14439, 1 Lancaster Circus Queensway, Birmingham, B2 2JE.

If any person wishes to question the validity of this Order or of any of the provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act or on the grounds that any requirements of the Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to this Order may within 6 weeks from the 17<sup>th</sup> December 2020 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
