The Centenary Square Extension is located in the Ladywood Ward, Ladywood Constituency. It is part of Birmingham City Council's (BCC) joint venture with the Midland Metro Alliance to extend the route of the Midland Metro Limited tramway.

Birmingham City Council propose to make a Traffic Regulation Orders under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to alter the existing waiting, parking and moving prohibitions, provisions and restrictions on Bridge Street, Broad Street, Gas Street, Berkley Street, Oozells Street, Granville Street, Sheepcote Street (both sections), Bishopsgate Street, Ryland Street, Five Ways underpass, Five Ways slip roads and Hagley Road as shown on the attached plans (0748-1 Speed limit plan 1 & 2, 0748-(2-3)_1 Movement & One Way Orders, 0748-(2-3-9)_2 Movement One Way & POMV Orders, 0748-(2)_3 Movement Order, 0748-4 Red Route plan 1 to 5, 0748-5 Bus Lanes plan 1 to 6, 0748-6 Inner Zone 406286 NWN, 0748-6 Inner Zone 406286 NWS, 0748-7 Waiting Restrictions and 0748-8 No Overtaking).

The formal reasons for proposing the new Traffic Regulation Orders are:

- a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
- b) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).
- c) for preventing the use of the road by vehicular traffic of a kind which, or its use by vehicular traffic in a manner which, is unsuitable having regard to the existing character of the road or adjoining property.
- d) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

The restrictions will enable the efficient operation of the new tramway, whilst assisting other road users including buses and hackney carriage taxis, as well as improving the facilities for pedestrians.
