STATEMENT OF REASONS

BIRMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL (ERDINGTON) (TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 20XX

Birmingham City Council propose to make a permanent Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the affect of which will be to implement a new Controlled Parking Zone, Monday to Saturday, 8am to 6pm in Erdington local centre. Restrictions within the Controlled Parking Zone include; Permit holders only parking bays and zones, pay for parking bays, limited waiting bays, disabled blue badge holder bays, motorcycle bays, no stopping at any time except taxis bays and waiting and loading restrictions. Outside of the Controlled Parking Zone extents, limited waiting bays and waiting restrictions will also to be implemented. Measures are as shown on drawing G_CA-02229_S1_001 RevA.

These proposals are located in the Erdington and Stockland Green Wards, in the Erdington Constituency. It forms part of the Economic Growth and Congestion Reduction Programme, which was approved by Cabinet in May 2013.

The formal reasons for proposing the new Order are:

- a) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians)
- b) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs
