## BIRMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL (A457 DUDLEY ROAD ETC NORTH EDGBASTON) (MOVEMENT) ORDER 202\*

Birmingham City Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

1. <u>Citation</u>

This Order may be cited as the "Birmingham City Council (A457 Dudley Road etc North Edgbaston) (Movement) Order 202\*" and shall come into operation on the 00<sup>th</sup> of Month two thousand and twenty year.

- 2. Interpretation
- (1) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:

"Contraflow Cycle Lane" means a length of carriageway specified as a Contraflow Cycle Lane which is reserved for Pedal Cycles and is signed in accordance with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 in which Pedal Cycles are authorised by a Traffic Regulation Order to proceed in the opposite direction to other traffic;

"Cycle Lane" means a length of carriageway specified as a Cycle Lane which is reserved for Pedal Cycles and is signed in accordance with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;

"Cycle Track" has the same meaning as in Section 329(1) of the Highways Act 1980;

"Highway" means all carriageways, footways, verges, cycle track and central reservations;

"Mechanical Road Cleansing Vehicle" means a vehicle used for the purposes of cleaning the Highway;

"Pedal Cycle" has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;

"Pedal Cycle Provision" means where the context permits a Cycle Lane, Contraflow Cycle Lane or Cycle Track;

"Road" means any length of Highway or any other road to which the public has access, and includes bridges over which a road passes as set out in Section 142(1) of the Act.

- (2) The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
- (3) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.
  - (i) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
    - ii) Where in any Article in this Order, reference is made to columns 2, 3, 4, etc as appropriate of a Schedule, these references relate to the corresponding entry in column 1 of that Schedule.
- (5) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament,

#### No Right Turns

3. Save as provided in Article 6, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in the Road or length of Road specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 on reaching the point specified in column 2 to make a right turn into the Road or length of Road specified in column 3 subject to any exceptions, if any, specified in column 4 of that Schedule.

#### No Left Turns

4. Save as provided in Article 6, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in the Road or length of Road specified in column 1 of Schedule 2 on reaching the point specified in column 2 to make a right turn into the Road or length of Road specified in column 3 subject to any exceptions, if any, specified in column 4 of that Schedule.

#### <u>No U-Turn</u>

5. Save as provided in Article 6, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in the Road or length of Road specified in column 1 of Schedule 3 in the direction, if any, specified in column 2 to make a U-turn at the location specified in column 3 subject to any exceptions, if any, specified in column 4 of that Schedule.

#### Exemption for Mechanical Road Cleansing

- 6. Nothing in Articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply to:
  - (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform;
  - (b) the driving of any Mechanical Road Cleansing vehicle being used in pursuance of statutory powers.
