NOTICE is hereby given that the above named Council propose to make these Orders under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32, 35, 101 and 102 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (as amended) and the Bus Lane Contraventions (Approved Local Authorities) (England) Order 2005 (as amended) and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be as follows:

- 1. To introduce and vary Pedestrian Zones on lengths of MOOR STREET QUEENSWAY, CARRS LANE, HIGH STREET, BULL STREET, MOOR STREET, PARK STREET and BULL RING
- 2. To introduce and vary waiting and loading restrictions on lengths of MOOR STREET QUEENSWAY AND MOOR STREET
- To introduce and vary bus lanes and bus only roads on lengths of MOOR STREET QUEENSWAY and MOOR STREET
