NOW THEREFORE the City of Birmingham District Council in pursuance of the powers contained in that behalf conferred by Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 hereby make the following order:-

- 1. The public right of way over the land situate between Wishaw Lane and Wiggins Hill Road Sutton Coldfield shown coloured brown on the map annexed hereto and described in the Schedule hereto shall be extinguished at the expiration of seven days from the date of confirmation of this Order
- 2. This Order may be cited as the City of Birmingham (Wishaw Lane No. 2) Public Path Extinguishment Order 1983

SCHEDULE

A footpath having a width of 1½ metres or thereabouts commencing at a point at Wishaw Lane approximately 350 metres north of its juntion with Summer Lane marked 'A' on the said map running in an easterly direction for 180 metres or thereabouts to a point marked 'B' on the said map and then in a south-easterly direction for 220 metres or thereabouts to a

point marked 'C' on the said map and then in a north-easterly direction for 340 metres or thereabouts to a point marked 'D' on the said map and then in an easterly direction for 26 metres or thereabouts through Wiggins Hill Farm to a point at its junction with Wiggins Hill Road marked 'E' on the said map
