

# Access and Movement

The site is located in a highly accessible location, with improved public transport access proposed as part of the wider Perry Barr regeneration. The design of the site responds to the regeneration proposals being progressed by Birmingham City Council.

## Site Access

Two points of vehicular access off Wellhead Lane are proposed:

- Franchise Street access retained and enhanced.
- New point of access created to the north of existing point of access to the National Express depot.

In addition a new access will be provided to west of Aldridge Road (Plot 10).

## Public Transport

- Excellent access to Perry Barr station and the new SPRINT bus stop on the A34.
- Enhanced public transport interchange adjacent to the One Stop shopping centre.

## Walking and Cycling

A well connected and legible network of walking and cycling routes are proposed.

- Enhanced pedestrian crossing facilities on the A34 and Aldridge Road.
- Connectivity to the new strategic cycle route along A34 Walsall Road.
- New dedicated cycle link via the new Commonwealth PARKour corridor.

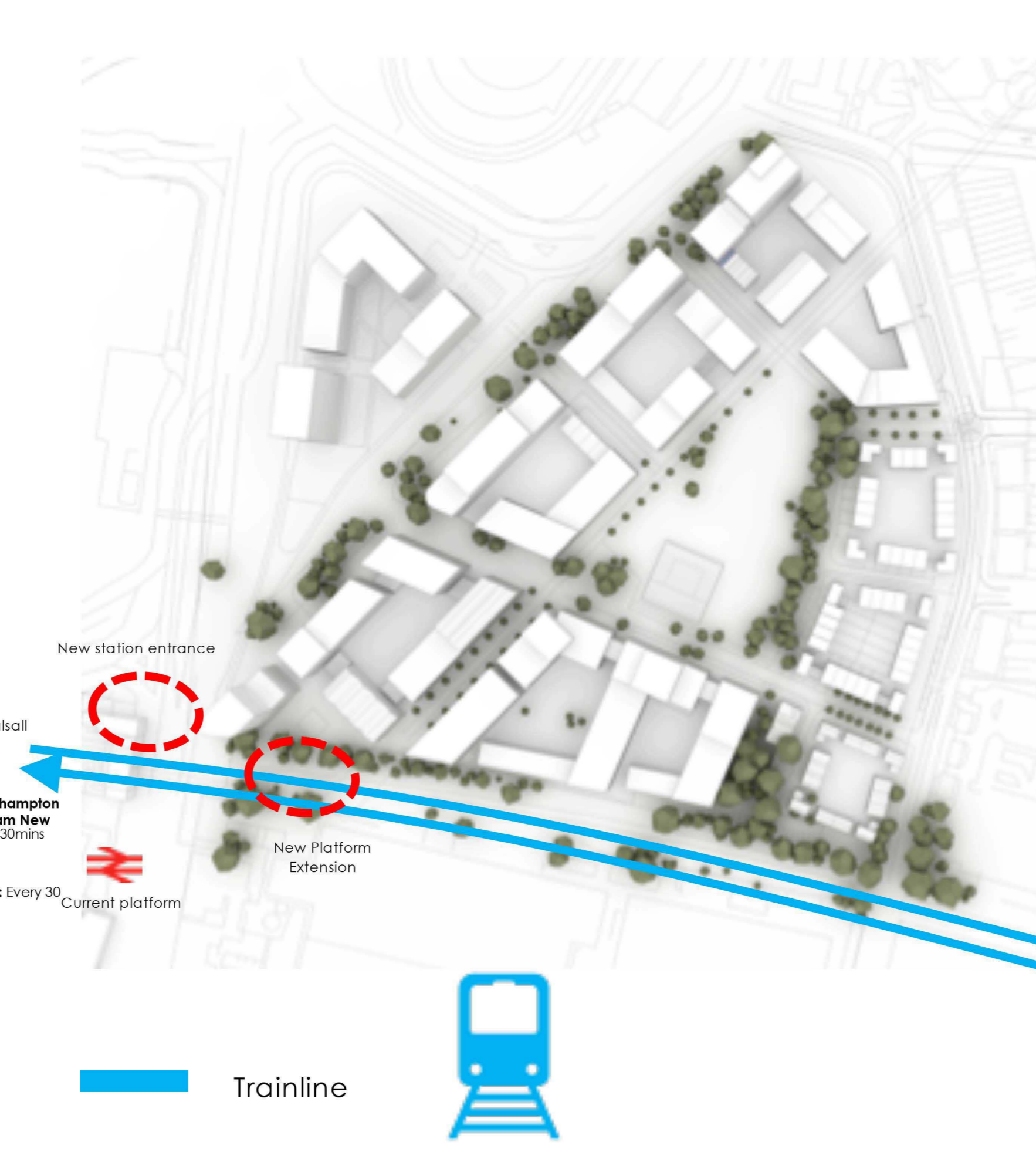

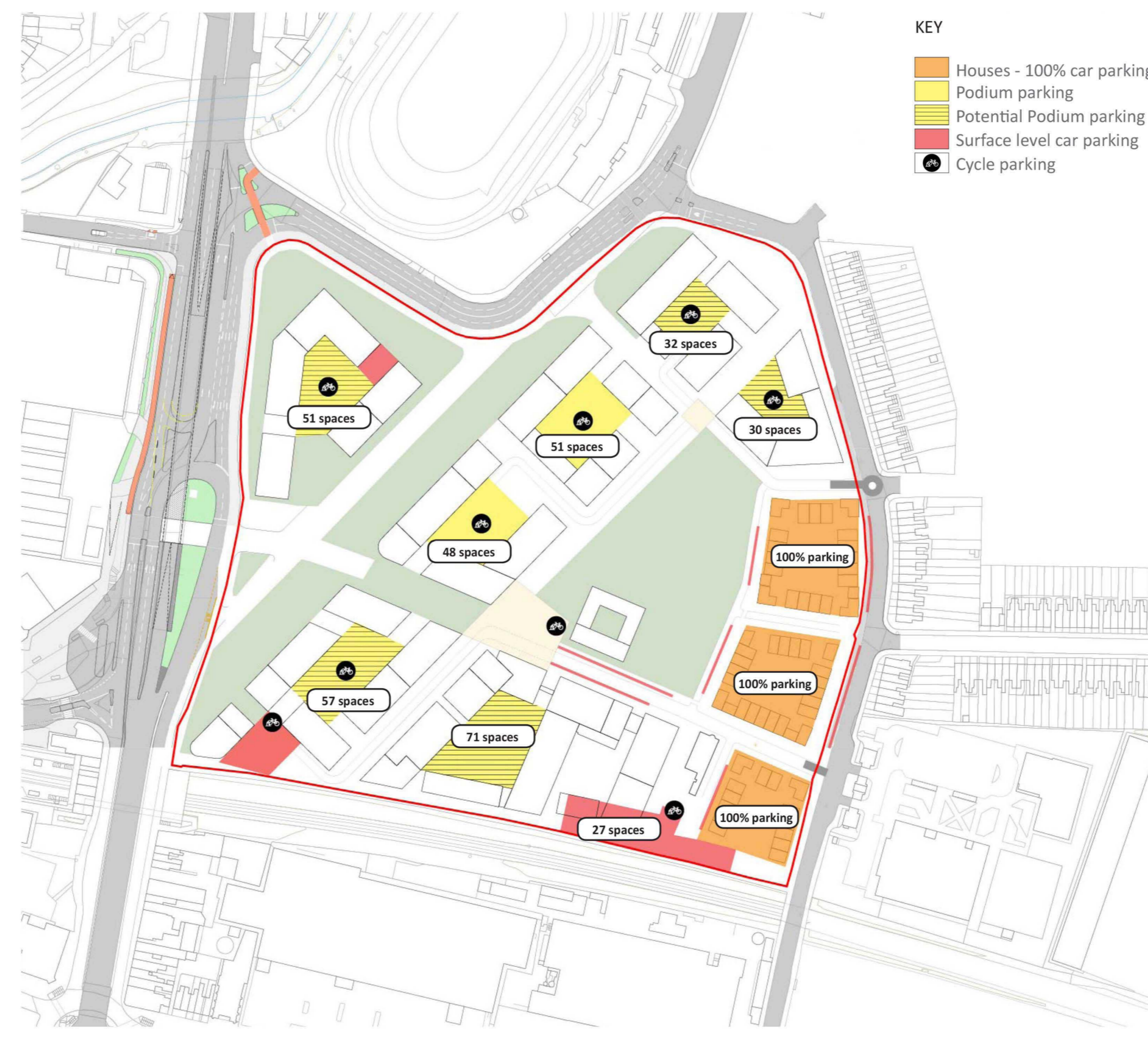

## Proposed Parking Provision



Housing provides 100% parking for residents  
 Site wide provides 15% parking for residents



Parking - 25% car parking provided across the site, in order to optimise and promote the use of sustainable transport methods which are to be enhanced as part of the scheme.

## Off Site Improvements

A number of off site transport and infrastructure improvements are being considered by Birmingham City Council. These include the potential for:

- Re-design of the A34 / Aldridge Road gyratory and flyover including partial closure of Aldridge Road
- Capping of the 'Birchfield Island' roundabout and replacement with a new signalised junction.
- Upgrade of Perry Barr railway station including a potential platform extension.
- A new public transport interchange adjacent to the One Stop shopping centre
- Dedicated SPRINT bus stop adjacent to the proposed development site.
