NOTICE is hereby given that the above named Council propose to make this Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53,101 and 102 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (as amended) the effect of which will be as follows:

- 1. To replace a No Waiting 8am 6pm restriction with a No Waiting at any Time and No Loading 8am 6pm restriction on a length of LIONEL STREET.
- 2. To replace a No Waiting at any time restriction with a No Waiting at any Time and No Loading 8am 6pm restriction on a length of NEWHALL STREET.
- 3. To replace a Parking Place with Payment 8am 6pm Max Stay 4 hrs No Return 2 hrs with a No Waiting at any Time and No Loading 8am 6pm restriction on lengths of LIONEL STREET and NEWHALL STREET.
