ORDER 202*

Birmingham City Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

1. The “Birmingham City Council (Various Roads, City Centre) (Traffic Regulation) (Movement) Order 2017” (as amended) shall continue in full force and effect subject to the variation specified in the SCHEDULE to this Order.
2. This Order shall come into operation on the ^{**th} of Month two thousand and year and may be cited as the “Birmingham City Council (Birmingham City Council (Various Roads, City Centre) (Traffic Regulation) (Movement) Order 2017) (0910 Variation) (No. *) Order 202*”.
