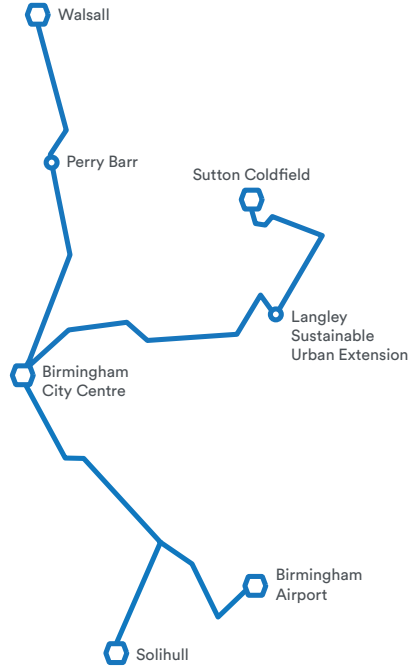

- Birmingham to Walsall (A34)
- Birmingham to Birmingham Airport & Solihull (A45)
- Sutton Coldfield to Birmingham via Langley

We will need to make some changes to road lanes, junctions, roadside parking and access along the Sprint routes to make sure we get the most out of these new services.
