PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDERS
A45 SPRINT. BORDESLEY CIRCUS TO SOLIHILL BOUNDARY.

NOTICE is hereby given that the above named Council propose to make these Orders under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53,101 and 102 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (as amended) and the Bus Lane Contraventions (Approved Local Authorities) (England) Order 2005 (as amended) and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be to:

- 1. Vary, introduce and consolidate stopping restrictions along lengths of the A45 COVENTRY ROAD RED ROUTE (SMALL HEATH HIGHWAY, POETS CORNER, HEYBARNES CIRCUS, A45 COVENTRY ROAD, NEW COVENTRY ROAD and adjoining side roads).
- 2. To introduce lengths of Bus Lane on SMALL HEATH HIGHWAY & A45 COVENTRY ROAD and lengths of Bus Only road on SMALL HEATH HIGHWAY & HEYBARNES CIRCUS.
- 3. To introduce a length of One Way Traffic on SMALL HEATH HIGHWAY & HEYBARNES CIRCUS.

SIGNALLED CONTROLLED PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLE CROSSINGS

NOTICE is hereby given that the above named Council intends under section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to:

- 1. Amend existing Pedestrian Crossings on SMALL HEATH HIGHWAY (eastbound carriageway) east of the junction with Golden Hillock Road and south west of the junction with Heybarnes Circus;
- 2. Amend existing Pedestrian Crossings on COVENTRY ROAD (eastbound carriageway) in the vicinity of GLADYS ROAD, GERALDINE ROAD, HENRY ROAD, HORSE SHOES LANE and SHEAF LANE (west of the junction);
- 3. Amend existing Pedestrian Crossings on COVENTRY ROAD (westbound carriageway) in the vicinity of CLAY LANE, WELLS LANE and ARDEN OAK ROAD (east of the junction)
