Sprint Phase 2 Consultation - A34 and A45 in Birmingham

Dear Resident,

Transport for West Midlands (TfWM), part of the West Midlands Combined Authority, will soon be starting Phase 2 of the Sprint scheme to create a bus priority corridor along the A34 and A45.

With Phase 1 now complete the second phase will see the introduction of extended bus lanes and further priority signalling with nine more Sprint shelters to be installed along the route. This will complete the Sprint corridor along the A34 and A45 in Birmingham, with work expected to begin later in the year.

We are opening a consultation on our Phase 2 proposals in Birmingham. This will run from 24 February until 24 March, 2023.

Our proposals include:

- further bus lane extensions along the A45 to complete continuous bus priority measures from Sheldon to Birmingham city centre
- junction improvements at Trinity Road and Newtown Middleway on the A34
- nine Sprint shelters along the A34 and A45
- moving the stops at the eastbound Wheatsheaf junction in Sheldon and Old Walsall Road southbound in Perry Barr.

We'll be holding two drop-in sessions (all are welcome, no appointment is required):

- A45 at Lyndon Methodist Church Community Room, Melton Avenue, Solihull, B92 7QX, on Wednesday 1 March between 5pm and 7pm
- A34 at Birchfield Library, 3 Trinity Road, Handsworth, B6 6AH, on Thursday 2 March between 2pm and 4pm.
