NOTICE is also hereby given that the above named Council propose to make these Orders under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, 101 and 102 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (as amended) the effect of which will be as follows:

1. To introduce Permit Holders only parking on SOUTHACRE AVENUE, SUDGEN GROVE, VERNOLDS CROFT, HODNET GROVE, EMILY STREET, KETLEY CROFT, EYTON CROFT, FERNDALE CRESCENT, JINNAH CLOSE, SHAWBURY GROVE, SALOP STREET, PENTLAND CROFT, MOWBRAY STREET, UXBRIDGE STREET, ALDGATE GROVE, MILFORD COURT, WESTHORPE GROVE, MOSBOROUGH CRESCENT, UNETT STREET, HADFIELD CROFT WINDLEY CLOSE, SPOONER CROFT, LAWFORDE GROVE, and UNETT WALK.
