

Birmingham City Council School Organisation Proposal

Colebourne Primary School

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that Birmingham City Council intends to make a prescribed alteration to Colebourne Primary School, (community school) Stechford Road, Birmingham B34 6BJ namely;

- To alter the lower age limit of Colebourne Primary School from age 4 years to become age 3 years;
- This proposal would change the age range to become 3 – 11 years with effect from 1st September 2019, resulting in the addition of nursery provision for up to 26 full time equivalent pupils aged 3 years at Colebourne Primary School. They will be accommodated in a purpose adapted area of the main school.

There will be no change to the admission arrangements at the school. The admission number will remain at 60 in reception. Priority will not be given to pupils in attendance at the nursery when applying for a place in reception.
