Proposal to Make Prescribed Alteration

The Pines Special School

Notice is given in accordance with section 19 of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 and regulation 6 of the School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013 that Birmingham City Council proposes to make the following prescribed alterations to The Pines Special School:

- Increase the number of pupil places that the school can offer from 190 to 230 with effect from 1st September 2019. These additional places will be created on a phased basis.

The Pines Special School is a foundation special school at Marsh Hill, Erdington, Birmingham B23 7EY which currently offers up to 190 places to pupils with a Statement of Special Educational Needs or an Education, Health and Care Plan for Autistic Spectrum Condition (ASC).
