Establishment of Special Educational Needs (SEN) provision to be provided in a resource base from 1st September 2022; making provision for up to 18 pupils with an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP) for Autistic Spectrum Conditions (ASC).

Ward End Primary School is a community school, rated "outstanding" by Ofsted, which has a capacity for 840 pupils and a nursery class which offers up to 52 part-time places. Remodelling work is proposed within the existing accommodation at the school to create the resource base area.
